Directions:

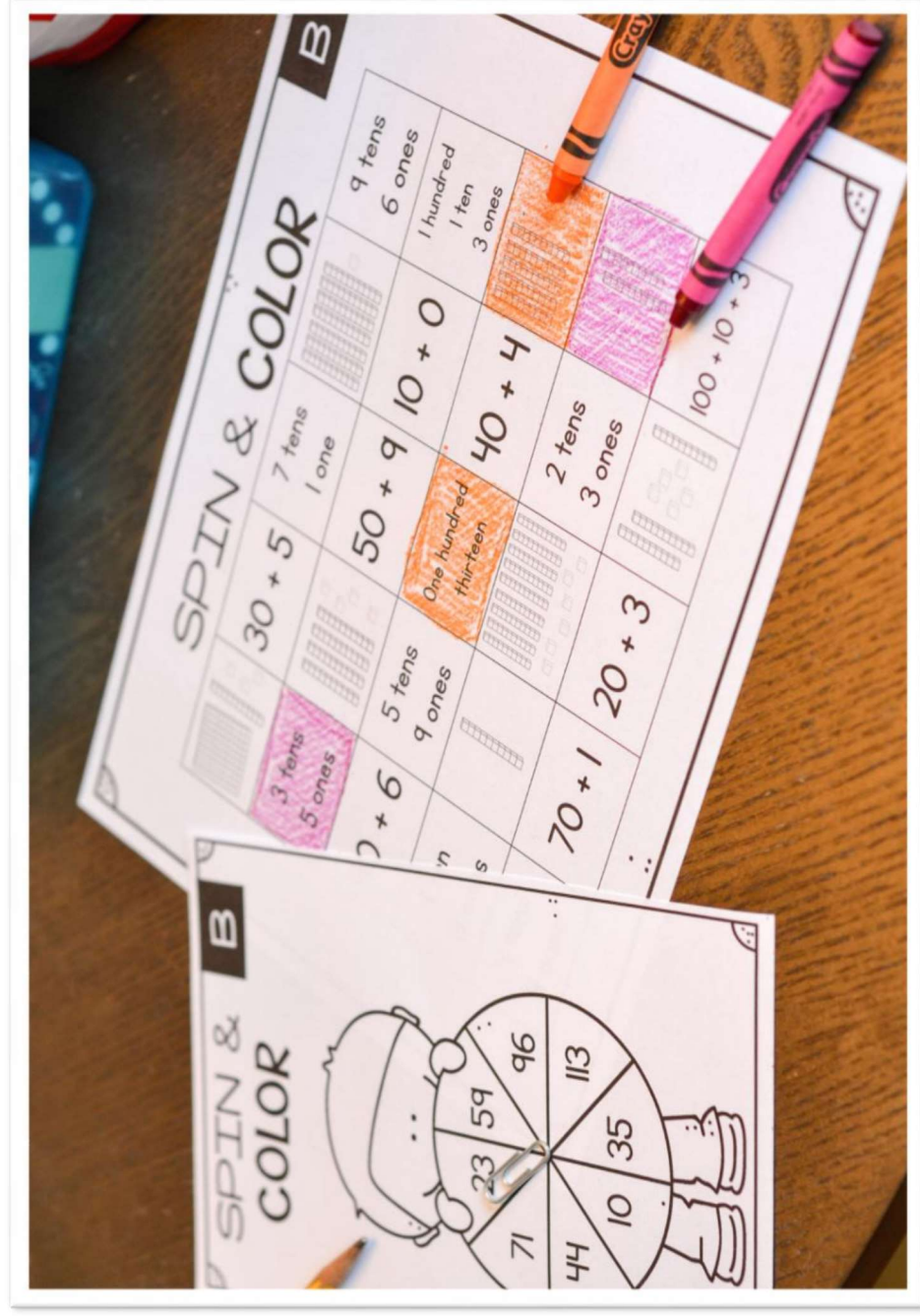
Make sure the spinner matches the board.

This game can also be played as 5-in-a-row and whoever get 5 in a row first, wins

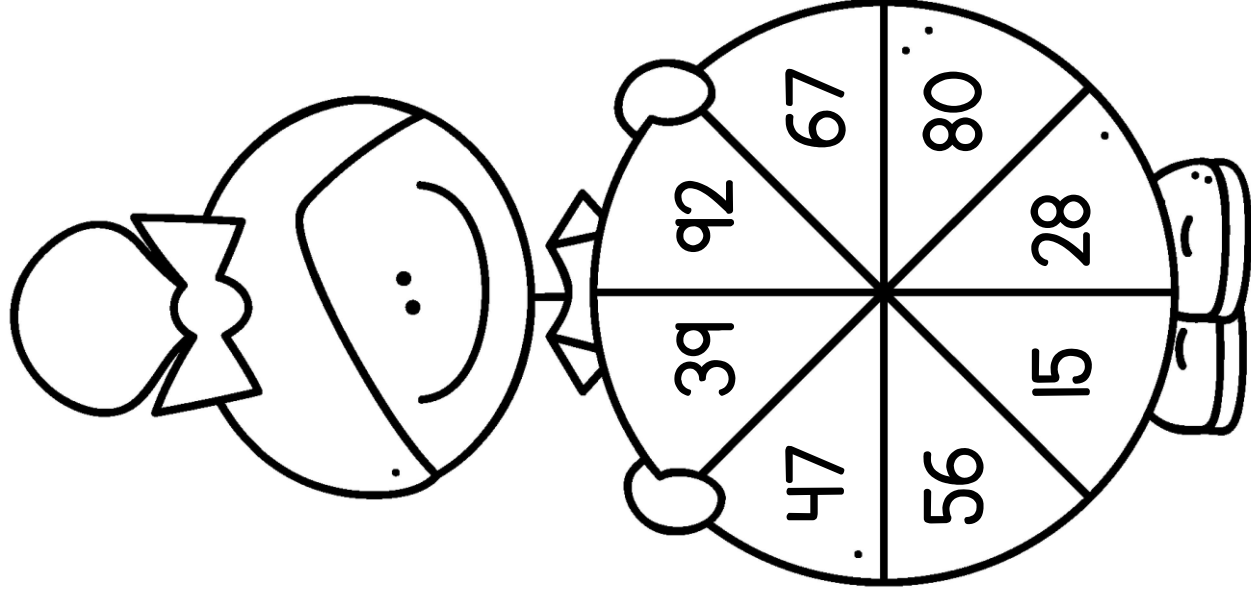
If you spin a number and cannot find an open space, your turn is skipped!
